






ADMIRALTY List of Lights Vol L 2020/21 (NP 84) Recommended requirement for all vessels








Norway Pilot Vol. IIIA (NP 58A) Recommended requirement for all vessels

This publication contains the Annual Statutory Notices to Mariners Numbers 1-26, a summary of Temporary and Preliminary Notices to Mariners still in force at the start of the year, and a Cumulative Summary of Amendments to ADMIRALTY Sailing Directions. The paper version of the Annual Summary of Notices to Mariners is published annually in January.


ADMIRALTY List of Radio Signals Volume 4, Meteorological Observation Stations (NP 284)








DP Operators Handbook (NI 507) *Recommended requirement for all vessels*




LNG Operational Practice. 2nd Edition (WITH 264) Recommended requirement for LNG carriers
